

THE 2021 WTA FANTASY TENNIS | PORSCHE RACE TO SHENZHEN CHALLENGE
Official Rules

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE IN OR WIN THIS CHALLENGE.

VOID WHERE PROHIBITED. CHALLENGE IS AVAILABLE FOR PARTICIPATION WORLDWIDE, HOWEVER ONLY RESIDENTS OF THE FIFTY (50) UNITED STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, GERMANY, THE UNITED KINGDOM, CANADA (INCLUDING THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC), ROMANIA, SPAIN, SINGAPORE, JAPAN, FRANCE, RUSSIA, AUSTRALIA, THE NETHERLANDS, BELGIUM, SWITZERLAND, SOUTH KOREA, AND THE CZECH REPUBLIC WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR PRIZING.

PARTICIPATION IN THIS CHALLENGE AND ACCEPTANCE TO BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES.

The 2021 WTA Fantasy Tennis | Porsche Race to Shenzhen Challenge (the “Challenge”) is a skill contest designed to increase consumer awareness of and interest in the WTA and the sport of women’s tennis. This Challenge may not be used for, or in connection with, any form of gambling. Chance will play no part in determining the winners of the Challenge. Participants will use their knowledge of the sport to compete for prizes. The prizes will be awarded to Participants with the highest scores. See below for complete details.

1. BINDING AGREEMENT: In order to enter the Challenge, You (“Participant” or “You”) must agree to these Official Rules (“Rules”). Therefore, please read these Rules prior to participating to ensure You understand and agree. By entering the Challenge, You agree to these Rules. You may not enter the Challenge, and are not eligible to receive any prize described in these Rules, unless You agree to these Rules. These Rules form a binding legal agreement between You and WTA with respect to the Challenge.

2. ELIGIBILITY: The Challenge will be available for participation worldwide, however to be eligible for the prizing in the Challenge outlined in Section 8 below, You must: (1) be at least eighteen (18) years old, or the age of majority in Your country, state, province, or jurisdiction of residence (whichever is greater), at the time of participation; (2) be a resident of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia, Germany, the United Kingdom, Canada (including the Province of Quebec), Romania, Spain, Singapore, Japan, France, Russia, Australia, the Netherlands, Belgium, Switzerland, South Korea, or the Czech Republic; and (3) have access to the Internet as of December 23, 2019. Participants agree that if they are a winner, they will provide any additional necessary information or consents necessary to confirm eligibility as a winner. Failure to provide additional necessary information or consents will be grounds for disqualification, unless prohibited under applicable law. The Challenge is void where prohibited by law. Employees, interns, contractors, and official office-holders of WTA Tour, Inc., Dr. Ing. h.c. F. Porsche Aktiengesellschaft (“Porsche”), Sports Technologies, LLC, and WTA tournament members, their respective subsidiaries, affiliates, and their respective directors, officers, employees, advertising and promotion agencies, representatives, and agents, and WTA player members and their coaches and agents (“Challenge Entities”), and members of the Challenge Entities and their immediate families (parents, siblings, children, spouses, and life partners of

each, regardless of where they live) and members of the households (whether related or not) of such employees, interns, contractors, officers, and directors may participate in the Challenge but are ineligible to for the prizing in the Challenge outlined in Section 8 below. WTA reserves the right to verify eligibility and to adjudicate on any dispute at any time.

3. SPONSOR: The Challenge is sponsored by WTA Tour, Inc. (“WTA” or “Sponsor”), with offices at 100 Second Avenue South, Suite 1100-S, St. Petersburg, Florida, USA.

4. CHALLENGE PERIOD: The Challenge begins at 12:00:00 A.M. Eastern Time (ET) Zone in the United States on December 21, 2020 and ends at 11:59:59 P.M. ET on December 15, 2021, or if due to scheduling changes, upon the completion of the last WTA tournament in Swing II, whichever is sooner (“Challenge Period”). The Challenge Period will be divided into two (2) individual selection periods (each, a “Swing Period”), as outlined in the chart below. *PARTICIPANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR DETERMINING THE CORRESPONDING TIME ZONE IN THEIR RESPECTIVE JURISDICTIONS.*

5. HOW TO PARTICIPATE: During the Challenge Period, visit <https://fantasy.wtatennis.com/> landing and follow the instructions to complete the online entry form. All entries must include a valid e-mail address for the Participant. **LIMIT OF ONE (1) ENTRY PER PARTICIPANT AND EMAIL ADDRESS THROUGHOUT THE CHALLENGE PERIOD.** Participants can only enter the Challenge in their own name. Participants may not use more than one (1) email address to participate in the Challenge. After submitting the online entry form, Participants will be able to play the Challenge and make selections based on their knowledge of the sport to earn Season Challenge Points and Tournament Challenge Points. Instructions on how to make selections and deadlines for selection are below. Selections are void if they are in whole or part counterfeit, obtained through fraud, or late. All selections will be deemed made by the authorized account holder of the email address used for selection, and the potential winners may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder for that email address. The "authorized account holder" is the natural person assigned to an email address by an Internet service provider, online

service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain.

6. HOW TO PLAY:

After registering, Participants can earn points for the opportunity to win the Challenge Grand Prize in one of two (2) ways:

1. Season Challenge Points - Based on their knowledge of the sport, Participants will have the opportunity to select the eight (8) WTA singles players that they think will qualify for the WTA Finals. WTA players earn ranking points based on their performance in each WTA tournament. Subject to the WTA Rules, the top eight (8) WTA players in the WTA Finals Rankings at the end of the regular WTA season qualify for the WTA Finals in Shenzhen. In the Challenge, Participants will have to apply their skills to select WTA players and then earn points equal to the actual ranking points earned by the WTA players they selected (“Season Challenge Points”).

- Participants cannot change their player selections after they lock in a selection.
- Participants do not have to select all eight (8) WTA players at once and can select their players at any time during the Challenge Period until they have filled all eight (8) WTA player spots.
- However, Participants cannot select WTA players that have already qualified for the WTA Finals. Participants can therefore select and lock in WTA players until the earlier of: (a) fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled start of the first WTA match of the last tournament of the season (i.e., Moscow), or (b) the date on which the top eight (8) WTA players qualify for the WTA Finals, which may occur at any stage during the season depending on player performance.
- Participants only will earn points from the time they lock in the selected WTA player until the end of the Challenge Period.* *For example, on June 1st, the WTA player Simona Halep sits in first place on the Porsche Race to Shenzhen leaderboard with 3,000 ranking points. If You select Simona on June 1st to be one (1) of Your eight (8) WTA players, and Simona goes on to qualify for the WTA Finals with 7,500 ranking points, You will receive a total of 4,500 points (7,500 – 3,000 = 4,500).* *Note that the Participant must lock in a WTA player at least fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled start of the first WTA match of that tournament to earn points for that tournament.
- Participants will only earn points if the WTA player they pick qualifies for the WTA Finals by finishing the regular season ranked in the top eight (8) of the WTA Finals Rankings (i.e., the final WTA player standings of the season). *For example, if the eight (8) WTA players You select finish the WTA season ranked 1, 3, 4, 6, 8, 10, 17, and 23, You would only earn points for the five (5) WTA players ranked in the top eight (8).*
- Points are earned and received based on the WTA players who finish the season ranked in the top (8) of the WTA Finals Rankings, regardless of whether those players actually play in the WTA Finals. *For example, if a WTA player that You selected finishes the season ranked in the top (8) of the WTA Finals Rankings, but subsequently withdraws from the WTA Finals due to injury or other reason, You would still earn points for that selection.*

Conversely, You would not earn points if You pick a WTA player who finished outside of the top eight (8) in the WTA Finals Rankings, but then subsequently plays in the WTA Finals as a replacement for a higher ranked WTA player who withdrew from the field.

- If a Participant locks in a selected WTA player while a tournament is in progress, Participant will not earn any points for that WTA player's performance at that tournament. Instead, Participant would begin earning points for that WTA player starting with the next tournament to begin after Participant has selected that WTA player. To earn points for a selected WTA player during a tournament, the Participant must have selected and locked that WTA player fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled start of the first WTA match of that tournament.
- For the Season Challenge, Participants earn points equal to the actual ranking points earned by their selected WTA players in ANY WTA-recognized tournaments during the Challenge Period (Grand Slams, WTA 1000s, WTA 500s, WTA 250s, WTA 125s, and ITF Circuit Events).

2. Tournament Challenge Points - Based on their knowledge of the sport, Participants also can earn Tournament Challenge Points. Participants will have the opportunity to select any four (4) WTA players ("Starting Lineup") and two (2) WTA player alternates for certain WTA 1000, WTA 500 and Grand Slam Tournaments throughout the 2021 WTA season.

- Participants will then earn Tournament Challenge Points based on the performance of the WTA players they have selected for that tournament. Tournament Challenge Points will be equal to the ranking points actually earned by the WTA players in that tournament. Ranking points (and therefore Tournament Challenge Points) vary based on the level of the tournament, as follows:

* Qualifier points will only be added to Participant's score if the selected Qualifier wins at least one main draw match.

- *For example, based on the above scoring, if Your four (4) WTA player selections finished the Rome tournament (a WTA 1000 tournament) as: 1) Winner, 2) Quarterfinalist, 3) Round of 32, and 4) Round of 32, You would get a total of 1,210 points (900 + 190 + 60 + 60).*
- Additionally, for each tournament in the Tournament Challenge, Participants may select one (1) WTA player from their Starting Lineup as their "Top Pick." Participants will then earn a ten percent (10%) bonus on any Tournament Challenge Points earned by the selected WTA player at that tournament, and such bonus will be added to the Participant's Tournament Challenge Points for that tournament.
- *For example, if the WTA player that You selected as Your Top Pick finished the Rome tournament (a WTA 1000 tournament) as the Winner, You would get a total of 990 points (900 standard points + 90 point bonus) for that player.*
- As the WTA season progresses, WTA will determine which WTA 1000, 500, 250, and Grand Slam Tournaments to include in the Tournament Challenge. The Tournament Challenge will consist of a minimum of five (5) tournaments and will only include tournaments that are completed in full prior to the end of the Challenge Period (i.e., December 1, 2020). The WTA will notify Participants in advance when new a new tournament is added to the Tournament Challenge by posting the update to the WTA Fantasy website and through email. Below is a tentative calendar of the tournaments included in the Tournament Challenge as of December 17, 2020. This calendar is subject to change.

The WTA calendar and WTA tournament names, levels, draw sizes, dates, and times are determined in the sole discretion of the WTA and the applicable tournament, and may be subject to change. WTA and the Challenge Entities will not be responsible for Acts of God, acts of terrorism, civil disturbances, work stoppage, weather, pandemic, outbreak of disease, or any other natural disaster which qualifies as a force majeure event or is outside WTA's control that may cause the cancellation or postponement of any WTA match.

WTA will notify Participants of any changes, additions, cancellations, or updates to the list of tournaments on the WTA Fantasy website at <https://fantasy.wtatennis.com/landing> and through email. Canceled tournaments will be removed from the Tournament Challenge, and Tournament Challenge Points will be awarded for a tournament only if that tournament is played in full through the completion of the final match.

All scoring and WTA player rankings are subject to the Official WTA Tour Rules available at <http://www.wtatennis.com/wta-rules>.

Making Picks and Line-up Changes:

- Depending on the tournament, Participants may make picks up to two (2) weeks ahead of each tournament start date, but picks lock fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled start of the first WTA match of that tournament. The tournament entry list is fluid and may change during the two weeks before the start of tournament play if WTA players withdraw from the tournament, so Participants are encouraged to edit their picks as

needed before picks lock. The player field within the Challenge will be updated once the tournament draw is announced – typically two to three days before the start of the first match.

- After the tournament draw is announced and the Challenge player field is updated, the Challenge will automatically remove from Participant's Starting Lineup any WTA players who have withdrawn from the tournament (up to two (2)), and replace the removed WTA player(s) with Participant's alternate WTA player selections in the order the Participant has ranked them (i.e., first alternate is moved into the starting lineup before the second alternate).
- If the player that Participant has selected as their Top Pick withdraws from the tournament prior to the scheduled start of the first WTA match of that tournament, the Participant must select a new player as their Top Pick for the tournament in order to earn the 10% bonus. The Challenge will not automatically apply the 10% bonus to another player among Participant's selections
- If a WTA player withdraws after tournament play begins, that WTA player will not be replaced in Participant's Starting Lineup and Participant cannot choose a replacement player or replacement Top Pick.

Prizing: One (1) Grand Prize will be awarded to the one (1) Participant with the highest number of combined Season Challenge Points and Tournament Challenge Points. In each Swing Period, one (1) Swing Prize will also be awarded to the one (1) Participant with the highest number of Tournament Challenge Points earned during that Swing Period (for a total of two (2) Swing Period winners). For each tournament in the Tournament Challenge, one (1) Tournament Prize will also be awarded to the Participant(s) with the highest number of Tournament Challenge Points earned during each tournament. If two (2) or more Participants finish a tournament tied with the highest number of Tournament Challenge Points, each Participant will receive a Tournament Prize.

Score Updates and Standings:

- WTA will make reasonable efforts to update Challenge points and standings on each Monday (Eastern Standard Time) during the Challenge Period that follows the completion of a tournament. If no tournament was completed during the preceding week, Challenge points and standings will be updated the following Monday.
- All posted standings and scores are unofficial and do not indicate actual prize winners.

Tiebreakers:

- Grand Prize Tiebreakers:
- First Tiebreaker: Based on their knowledge of the sport, Participant must select the number of aces in total that will occur during 2021 WTA Finals (singles only). The selection will be made on the Season Challenge selection page. The Participant who chooses the number closest to the actual number of aces wins.
- Second Tiebreaker: If two (2) or more Participants are still tied after the first tiebreaker is

used, the Participant who picked the most WTA tournament finalists (winners + finalists) in the Tournament Challenge (across all Swing Periods) wins.

- Third Tiebreaker: If two (2) or more Participants are still tied after the second tiebreaker is used, each tied Participant will be required to submit an essay to Sponsor no more than one hundred (100) words in length on a specific topic to be determined by Sponsor, in its sole discretion. Sponsor will then judge the essays received from Participants using a specific set of judging criteria, and the one (1) essay that received the highest score will be deemed the winner.
- Tournament Challenge Swing Prize Tiebreakers:
 - First Tiebreaker: Based on their knowledge of the sport, Participant must select the number of aces in total that will occur during the final tournament of that Swing Period. The selection will be made when the Participant first enters that Swing Period. The Participant who chooses the number closest to the actual number of aces wins.
 - Second Tiebreaker: If two (2) or more Participants are still tied after the first tiebreaker is used, the Participant who picked the most WTA tournament finalists (winners + finalists) in that Swing Period wins.
 - Third Tiebreaker: If two (2) or more Participants are still tied after the second tiebreaker is used, each tied Participant will be required to submit an essay to Sponsor no more than one hundred (100) words in length on a specific topic to be determined by Sponsor, in its sole discretion. Sponsor will then judge the essays received from Participants using a specific set of judging criteria, and the one (1) essay that received the highest score will be deemed the winner.

7. WINNER DETERMINATION: At the conclusion of each Swing Period and the Challenge Period, all Participant scores will be calculated by WTA representatives in the United States to determine the winners of the Swing Prizes and Grand Prize as applicable. The Prizes will be awarded to the top scoring Participants as described below. One (1) Grand Prize will be awarded to the one (1) Participant with the highest number of combined Season Challenge Points and Tournament Challenge Points. In each Swing Period, one (1) Swing Prize will also be awarded to the one (1) Participant with the highest number of Tournament Challenge Points accrued during that Swing Period (for a total of two (2) Swing Period winners). Tournament Prizes will also be awarded to the Participant(s) with the highest number of Tournament Challenge Points accrued during each tournament.

WTA will use commercially reasonable efforts to notify potential winners via email within two (2) weeks after conclusion of each Swing Period or the Challenge Period (as applicable), with a subsequent postal confirmation where required by law. If a potential winner does not respond to the notification attempt within three (3) calendar days from the date of notification attempt, then such potential winner will be disqualified, and (at WTA's sole and absolute discretion) an alternate potential winner may be selected from among all eligible Participants based on the scoring criteria described herein. Each potential winner may be required to sign and return a Declaration of Eligibility and Liability and Publicity Release (similar to the sample document in Exhibit A below) and provide any additional information, such as that referenced in Section 9 below, that may be required by WTA. Each potential winner and guest must also complete a

credential application as instructed by WTA. WTA will use the information provided via the credential application to conduct a background check, and the potential winner's enjoyment of the prize (or certain prize elements) is subject to the potential winner and guest having passed such background check to WTA's satisfaction. Potential winners must return all such required documents within three (3) calendar days following attempted notification or such potential winner will be deemed to have forfeited the prize, and (at WTA's sole and absolute discretion) another potential winner may be selected based on the scoring criteria described herein. All notification requirements, as well as other requirements within these Rules, will be strictly enforced. Determinations of WTA are final and binding.

In the event all prizes are not awarded (or which remain unclaimed after two (2) months from the date of announcement of the winners) the remaining prizes or their equivalent value shall be donated to a charity of WTA's choice.

8. PRIZES:

8.1. Grand Prize (1). The overall Challenge Grand Prize winner will receive a trip for the winner and one (1) guest to a 2022 WTA tennis tournament of Sponsor's choosing. Trip consists of round-trip coach class air transportation from a major international airport near winner's residence to an airport near the tournament, hotel accommodations (one (1) room, double occupancy) for a select number of nights, ground transportation to/from the tournament site and hotel, VIP hospitality treatment and two (2) tickets for up to three (3) tournament sessions at the tournament, and VIP activities and experiences provided by Porsche for two (2) people. Approximate Retail Value of Grand Prize package: €3,100.00. Actual value may vary based on point of departure and dates of travel. Any difference between stated value and actual value will not be awarded. The tournament, tournament airport, and tournament hotel will be determined by Sponsor, in its sole discretion. Travel must be completed within three (3) days before and after the dates that the tournament is held (the exact travel dates to be specified by Sponsor), or prize will be forfeited and Sponsor will have no further obligation to winner.

8.2. Swing Prizes. The Swing 1 Prize winner and Swing 2 Prize winner will each receive a trip for winner and one (1) guest to a WTA tennis tournament of Sponsor's choosing. Trip consists of round-trip coach class air transportation from a major international airport near winner's residence to an airport near the tournament, hotel accommodations (one (1) room, double occupancy) for a select number of nights, ground transportation to/from the tournament site and hotel, and VIP hospitality treatment and two (2) tickets for up to two (2) tournament sessions at the tournament. Approximate Retail Value of each Swing Prize package: €6,300.00. Actual value may vary based on point of departure and dates of travel. Any difference between stated value and actual value will not be awarded. The tournament, tournament airport, and tournament hotel will be determined by Sponsor, in its sole discretion. Travel must be completed within three (3) days before and after the dates that the tournament is held (the exact travel dates to be specified by Sponsor), or prize will be forfeited and Sponsor will have no further obligation to winner.

8.3. Tournament Prizes. Each Tournament Prize winner(s) will receive one (1) signed tennis ball from a WTA Player. The particular player will be determined by WTA in its sole discretion. Approximate Retail Value of Tournament Prize: \$75. Actual value may

vary based on the exact nature of the signed memorabilia. Any difference between stated value and actual value will not be awarded.

8.4. Prize Conditions. In the event Sponsor is unable to provide tickets, travel, or other prize elements for winner and guest to the tournaments described above (whether as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, associated travel restrictions, or for any other reason), Sponsor reserves the right to substitute portion of prize with a comparable event or prize, and remainder of prize package will be awarded, and Sponsor will have no further obligation to winner. Winner and guest must comply with all laws, rules, and regulations. In the event winner elects to rent a car while on trip, such car rental will be subject to winner and/or guest holding a valid driver's license and qualifying as an eligible driver under applicable car rental company policy and other rental car company terms and conditions. Winner and guest must travel together on the same itinerary. Transportation to/from departure airport not included. Winner and guest are responsible for obtaining all travel documents, including passports and/or visas, as applicable. Guest must be of legal age of majority in his/her jurisdiction of residence (and at least 18), unless a child or legal ward of winner and must sign a liability/publicity release (similar to the sample document provided in Exhibit A) prior to issuance of travel documents. If guest is a child or legal ward of winner, winner must sign and return release on behalf of such child or legal ward. Travel is subject to availability and confirmation at time of booking. If winner or guest declines to accept the prize or any portion thereof for any reason, no substitute prizing will be awarded, except in Sponsor's sole discretion.

Acceptance and use of a Prize is subject to any terms and conditions imposed by third parties (such as hotels or airlines) involved in providing goods and/or services as part of or in connection with the Prize ("Third Party Terms"). Each winner is responsible for complying with all applicable Third Party Terms, and bears all risk associated with failure to comply with them. The Challenge Entities assume no liability (and will provide no compensation) as a result of any failure to comply with any Third Party Terms.

No transfer, substitution, or cash equivalent for prizes is allowed, except at Sponsor's sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize, in whole or in part, of equal or greater monetary value if a prize cannot be awarded, in whole or in part, as described for any reason. Winner may not assign prizes to third parties. WTA is not responsible for: (a) lost, late, damaged, destroyed, delayed, stolen, misdirected, incomplete, or illegible garbled selections, or selections received through impermissible or illegitimate channels, all of which will be disqualified; (b) technical failures of any kind, including but not limited to the malfunctioning of any telephone, computer online systems, computer equipment, website, server provider, network, hardware, or software; (c) the unavailability or inaccessibility of any website or service; (d) unauthorized intervention in any part of the selection process or the Challenge; (e) printing, typographical, electronic, or human errors which may occur in the offer or administration of the Challenge, the processing of selections, or the tabulation of scores, or (f) the cancellation of matches or any errors appearing in any Challenge related-materials. FOR QUEBEC ENTRANTS: Any litigation respecting the conduct or organization of a publicity contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. Any litigation respecting the awarding of the prize may be submitted to the Régie only for the purpose of helping the parties reach a settlement.

18. To the extent permitted by law, the rights to litigate, seek injunctive relief or make any other recourse to judicial or any other procedure in case of disputes or claims resulting from or in connection with this Challenge are hereby excluded, and all Participants expressly waive any and all such rights.

19. DISPUTES: By entering the Challenge, Participant agrees that all disputes between Participant and WTA of whatsoever kind or nature arising out of these Rules, shall be subject to WTA's standard Terms of Service available at <http://www.wtatennis.com/terms-and-conditions-use>. The Challenge and all scoring is subject to the Official WTA Tour Rules available at <http://www.wtatennis.com/wta-rules>.
